Commitment	The Club commits to you for the full year and registration is required twice during the calendar year for two seasons: Indoor Season (October) and Outdoor (March). This email represents the Outdoor Season 2022 Registration information.
Length of Program	The outdoor season will operate from April 4, 2022 until the end of September 2022
New for Outdoor 2022	Weekly training sessions increased from two (2) to three (3) per week Half-day summer development camp included (5 days in July) All sessions are run by certified technical coaching staff
Outdoor Training	U8-U10 - Three (3) 60 minute sessions per week U11-U12 - Three (3) 75 minute sessions per week
Outdoor Leagues	Teams are registered to participate in Development Peel Halton Soccer League
Days of Play by Age Group	Saturdays or Sundays
New Players & ID Sessions	All new players are required to attend ID sessions before committing to registration. This allows players to understand the level of commitment, play and coaching before registering for the program. Information on the club's ID sessions can be found on the club's website.
Program Structure	Year-round programming; Breaks on statutory holidays; Winter Break (Holidays) Indoor games will be played on turf fields or gyms (i.e. Futsal) Outdoor games will be played on grass and turf fields
