



Welcome to the 2022/2023 Soccer Season Program Outline for U13 (2010) - U18 (2005)

This document outlines the relevant program details and registration process for families that are returning or joining the NMSC for the first time.

Commitment: Our programs run continuously for 12-months with the exception of scheduled breaks and certain holidays. Your registration is required twice per year, commencing with the Indoor season (September 2022) and Outdoor season (March 2023)

League Play: Your team will be registered in the MYSL league for the winter season. The league commences at the end of October and concludes in early April 2023. (Start and end times vary based on the division)

Indoor Training: The Club will provide your team with two training sessions on turf and one training session in a school gymnasium on a weekly basis. From time-to-time, due to holidays observed, facility availability, or special events, the Club may temporarily modify that week's training schedule.

Roster Size: Coaches are permitted to carry upwards of 18-20 players on a roster.

Program Structure: Winter Break (December 23, 2022 to January 8, 2023)
Family Day (February 20, 2023)
March Break (March 13 to 17, 2023)
Good Friday (April 7, 2023)

Program Fees: \$1,725* for registration period of October 1, 2022 to April 9, 2023

*For your convenience, we included the MYSL League Fee to save you the extra step of paying an additional amount to your team account.

Registration due by September 30, 2022 to confirm your placement on the team.

Payment is available by one-time payment or 3-equal instalments
