



**Welcome to the 2022/2023 Soccer Season
Program Outline for U19 Reserve Women (2005 – 2006)**

This document outlines the relevant program details and registration process for players that are joining the U19 Women Reserve program.

Commitment: The program will run continuously for 12-months with the exception of scheduled breaks and certain holidays. Your registration will be required twice per year, commencing with the Indoor season (November 2022) and Outdoor season (April 2023)

League Play: Your team will be registered in the League1 U19 Reserve league for summer play only. No indoor league play is included.

Tournament: Entry fees for FTF, Durham (Women Only), and Umbro tournaments included.

Roster Size: Coaches are permitted to carry upwards of 25 players on the roster.

Program Structure: Winter Break (December 23, 2022 to January 8, 2023)
Family Day (February 20, 2023)
March Break (March 13 to 17, 2023)
Good Friday (April 7, 2023)

Program Fees: \$3,950 for registration period of November 1, 2022 to end of season or October 31, 2023 (whichever occurs first)

Registration due by October 31, 2022 to confirm your placement on the team for the indoor season.
