

Welcome to the 2022/2023 Soccer Season Program Outline for U21 Reserve (2002 – 2006)

This document outlines the relevant program details and registration process for players that are joining the U21 Men Reserve program.

Commitment: The program will run continuously for 11-months with the exception of

scheduled breaks and certain holidays. Your registration will be required twice per year, commencing with the Indoor season (October 2022) and

Outdoor season (February 2023)

League Play: Your team will be registered in the League1 U21 Reserve league for

summer play only. No indoor league play is included.

Tournament: Entry fees for Sigma, FTF, and Umbro (Spring) tournaments included.

Roster Size: Coaches are permitted to carry upwards of 25 players on the roster.

Program Structure: Winter Break (December 23, 2022 to January 8, 2023)

Family Day (February 20, 2023) March Break (March 13 to 17, 2023)

Good Friday (April 7, 2023)

Commitment: Players are NOT guaranteed a roster place on the team for the summer

program.

Program Fees: \$1,500 for registration period of October 1, 2022 to February 25, 2023

\$2,000 for the registration period of February 26, 2023 to end of season

Registration due by October 26, 2022 to confirm your placement on the

team for the indoor season.

Payment is available by one-time payment or 2-equal instalments

Payment Schedule: October 28, 2022 \$750

November 25, 2022 \$750

You will be required to order additional items – your coach will communicate with you. The Club retains the jerseys for use for two season(s). Jerseys are returned after every game for laundering.
