Position Overview:

The North Mississauga Soccer Club seeks a dynamic and highly motivated individual to lead the position of "Summer Camp Coach" to support the very important delivery of our Summer Camp Soccer program. The position will primarily operate out of Streetsville Memorial Park located at 335 Church Street in Mississauga. If you are an outgoing, strong leader, quick thinker, problem solver, and enjoy working with children, this role may be perfect for you! The position is primarily outdoor and you will be working in all weather conditions.

Key Responsibilities:

- Check in and sign out registrants each day to ensure safety measures
- Deliver engaging and challenging soccer coaching sessions for players of all skill levels based on session plans provided by the Technical Recreational Management Team.
- Execute age-appropriate training sessions and adapt the session accordingly
- Create a fun and positive learning environment for players
- Supervise and mentor volunteers supporting the camp sessions
- Communicate with parents about the progress of their child during camp
- Ensure the safety and well being of all players
- Assist with any minor injuries of players
- Assist with set up and take down of equipment and fields
- Monitor that lunches and snacks are peanut free and be aware of any player allergies or medicinal on-player needs
- Lead a multitude of other fun activities for players
- Complete any incident reports occurring at our summer camp program



Qualifications:

- Pursuing or hold a Bachelor's degree in sports management, recreation, education, or a related field, an asset.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills, with the ability to convey information effectively to diverse stakeholders
- A soccer background and previous experience coaching youth soccer
- Understanding of the principles of player development
- Ability to work well with children of all skill levels and backgrounds
- Ability to excel as part of a team
- Strong leadership and organization skills with the ability to multitask
- Ability to set up and tear down equipment, including event tent frames
- Experience managing and/or working with volunteers
- First Aid & CPR Certification Required
