### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

North Mississauga SC offers this co-ed weekly program to provide an opportunity for players with developmental and physical disabilities to enjoy the game of soccer. We want to celebrate everyone's participation with NMSC! Certified Coaches will lead the delivery of the program. Parents are welcome to participate with their players.

### KEY ELEMENTS OF THE PROGRAM

1. **Format:** This program is designed for co-ed players aged 5 + for players who are physically capable of participating without any serious medical condition that would put them at risk. A parent or guardian must remain at the facility during each session.
2. **Focus:** The focus of the Panther Stars program is to develop the players at their own pace in a fun and healthy environment. We want to promote inclusion and help the players with skill development, team play, making friends, and being active through soccer for life!
3. **Curriculum:** The physical training curriculum consists of warm up exercises and ball control/skill activities.

### WHAT IS INCLUDED

- 1 Session per week on Grass Field
- Recreational Training Uniform -Jersey, shorts, socks (cleats and shin guards not included)
- Communication Tools -PowerUp
- Player Insurance -Ontario Soccer

- Qualified Coaches with Mandatory Coach education courses completed
- All Coaches 18+ with valid VSC
- Programs align with age-specific Ontario Soccer Standards

Players are required to bring their own soccer cleats and shin pads or they will not be allowed to participate due to safety reasons. Also, jewellery and casts of any kind are not allowed.

## REGISTRATION

To secure your place in the program, all registrations are completed online on PowerUp through the link on our NMSC website. Spots are limited. Once registered and players are rostered closer to program start date, the weekly schedule and sub-field location can be viewed on PowerUp.
